- CBI ACB Delhi intends to create a panel of advocates for CBI, ACB, Delhi branch. In this regard, applications are invited from the eligible advocates for engagement as Special Public Prosecutors in CBI to conduct trial of CBI cases in Courts in New Delhi.
- PROFESSIONAL FEE: The professional fee for the advocates will be governed by the terms & conditions contained in DoPT F.No.225/19/2023-AVD-II dated 08.04.2024 (copy enclosed).
- 3. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:** The following eligibility criteria may be considered carefully by the applicant while submitting the application for the appointment/engagement of CBI, Special Public Prosecutors to conduct trial of CBI cases before the Courts/CBI Courts in Delhi:
 - i. Education qualification : LLB
 - ii. Enrolment Certificate as an Advocate with the Bar Counsel.

- iii. Experience of BAR of handling criminal matters in Sessions courts
- iv. An unconditional willingness / consent to work on the general terms and conditions approved by the Govt. of India from time to time.
- v. A minimum experience of 10 years as an Advocate with experience in handling criminal matters.
- 4. ENGAGEMENT PERIOD: 03 years
- 5. **NATURE OF JOB:** To conduct trial of all CBI cases pending in Courts/CBI Courts in Delhi.
- 6. **DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONGWITH THE APPLICATION**: Following documents are required to be submitted along with the application:
 - i. Copies of Educational qualifications.
 - ii. Copy of Enrolment Certificate as an advocate with the Bar Counsel.

 - iv. An unconditional willingness / consent to work on the general terms & conditions, approved by the Govt. of India.

	Out of Headquarters	If the Counsel is required to go out of Headquarters in connection with conducting the CBI cases e.g. for appearance in court outside the Headquarters, he will be entitled to a daily fee of Rs. 1000/- per day for the days of his absence from the Headquarters including the days of the departure from, intervening holidays and arrival back at the Headquarters.
		Provided that no fee will be paid for the day of departure if he leaves the Headquarters after court hours or for the day of arrival if he arrives at the Headquarters before the court hours.

Travel/Hotel Expenses	In addition to the daily fee, the counse will also be entitled to travel expense for travel by air (economy class)/ACtier or first class by train, road mileag for the journey from his headquarters the airport/railway station and vice versa and from the airport./railway station to the place of his stay out of Headquarters and vice-versa at the rate admissible to the Group A Gazett Officer of the Central Government, he will also be paid conveyance charges for performing local journey while outsid the Headquarters at the rates as admissible to the Group A Gazette Officer subject to a maximum of Rs.338/- per day, he will also be entitled to a reasonable actual expense for stay in Hotel at the rates as admissible to the Group A Gazette Officer subject to a maximum of Rs.2250/- per day in terms of instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance from time to time.

	Out of Pocket Expenses	The amount required for court fees at the time of filing a case; and other miscellaneous expenses not exceeding Rs. 750/- should be obtained by the counsel in advance from the concerned branch/unit of CBI on whose behalf the Counsel will conduct the cases in the trial court. An account of the expenses incurred should be rendered to the concerned branch/Unit while presenting the final fee bill.

- 2. The expenditure involved will be met from the budget grant of Central Bureau of Investigation.
