 - (ii) Enrolment Certificate as an Advocate with the Bar Council.

- (iii) Experience at BAR of handling criminal matters in Sessions Courts.
- (iv) Unconditional willingness/consent to work on the general terms & conditions approved by Government of India from time to time.
- (v) Details of important cases handled by the applicant advocate.
- (vi) A minimum standing of 10 years as an Advocate is required for considering an Advocate for CBI Special Public Prosecutor (CBI Special Courts and Subordinate Courts), who have experience in handling criminal matters.
- **4. Period**: Minimum 03 years.
- **5. Nature of Job:** To conduct CBI cases in the Trial Courts at Bangalore and Dharwad(Karnataka).

Provided that no fee will be paid for the day of departure if he leaves the Headquarters after court hours or for the day of arrival if he arrives at the Headquarters before the court hours.

An account of the expenses incurred should be rendered to the concerned branch/Unit while presenting the final fee bill.
