
ADVERTISEMENT FOR APPOINTMENT/ENGAGEMENT OF SPECIAL PUBLIC PROSECUTOR IN CBI, EOB, KOLKATA TO CONDUCT UNDER TRIAL CBI CASES IN THE COURTS- REG.

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1. CBI, EOB, Kolkata intends to create a panel of advocates to conduct under trial cases for the Branch. In this regard, applications are invited from the eligible advocates for engagements of Special Public Prosecutor in CBI to conduct trial of CBI cases in the Courts located in the State of West Bengal.
2. PROFESSIONAL FEE- The professional fees of the Advocates will be governed by the terms & conditions in DoPT ID No. 225/19/2023-ADV-II dated 08.04.2024 (copy attached).
3. ELEGIBILITY CRITERIA- The following eligibility criteria may be considered carefully by the applicant while submitting the application for the appointment/engagement of CBI Special Public Prosecutors to conduct trial of CBI cases before the CBI Courts located in the state of West Bengal:-
 - I. Educational Qualification of LLB.
 - II. Enrollment Certificate as an advocate with the Bar Courts.
 - III. Experience at BAR of handling criminal matters in Sessions Courts.
 - IV. An unconditional willingness to work on the general terms & conditions approved by Government of India from time to time.
 - V. A minimum standing of 10 years as an advocate with experience in handling criminal matters.
4. ENGAGEMENT PERIOD- 3 years.
5. NATURE OF JOB- To conduct trial of CBI cases pending under trial in the state of West Bengal.

6. DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED ALONGWITH THE APPLICATION- The following documents are required to be uploaded along with the application:-

- I. Copies of Educational Qualification.
 - II. Copy of Enrollment Certificate as an Advocate with Bar Council.
 - III. Experience at BAR of handling criminal matters in Trial Courts/Sessions Courts.
 - IV. An unconditional willingness/ consent to work on the general terms & conditions approved b y Government of India.
 - V. Details of important cases handled by the applicant Advocate.
7. The complete application in the attached prescribed format along with the requisite documents should be submitted through online link. Incomplete applications and applications submitted offline shall not be considered. Further, no applications shall be entertained by CBI, which are submitted after last date of submission of application. It may be noted that after scrutiny of applications, suitable candidates may be called for interaction/interview at CBI Office, Kolkata. They shall have to bring all the uploaded and supporting documents in original during the interaction/interview.

1.	For appearance in Trial Courts	Effective hearing Rs. 7,500/- per case per day Non-effective hearing 1/3 rd of the Effective hearing if after appearance in the court, effective hearing could not take place and circumstances were beyond the control of the Special Counsel.
2.	Drafting fee per pleading	Rs. 2,000/-
3.	Conference charges	Rs. 600/- per hour per conference subject to maximum 5 conferences in an individual case/Group of cases.
4.	Out of Pocket expenses	Rs. 750/- per case
5.	Travelling Allowance	At the rates as admissible to the Gazetted Officers (Group-A)

(C) Other entitlements which are as under:

S. No.	Particulars	Proposed Fee
1.	Out of Headquarters	If the Counsel is required to go out of Headquarters in connection with conducting the CBI cases e.g. for appearance in court outside the Headquarters, he will be entitled to a daily fee of Rs. 1000/- per day for the days of his absence from the Headquarters including the days of the departure from, intervening holidays and arrival back at the Headquarters. Provided that no fee will be paid for the day of departure if he leaves the Headquarters after court hours or for the day of arrival if he arrives at the Headquarters before the court hours.


S. No.	Particulars	Proposed Fee
2.	Travel/Hotel Expenses	In addition to the daily fee, the counsel will also be entitled to travel expenses for travel by air (economy class)/AC-II tier or first class by train, road mileage for the journey from his headquarters to the airport/railway station and vice-versa and from the airport./railway station to the place of his stay out of Headquarters and vice-versa at the rates admissible to the Group A Gazette Officer of the Central Government, he will also be paid conveyance charges for performing local journey while outside the Headquarters at the rates as admissible to the Group A Gazetted Officer subject to a maximum of Rs.338/- per day. he will also be entitled to a reasonable actual expense for stay in Hotel at the rates as admissible to the Group A Gazetted Officer subject to a maximum of Rs.2250/- per day in terms of instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance from time to time.
3.	Clerkage	The Counsel will be entitled to 10% of fees subject to a maximum of Rs. 1800/- in a case or batch of cases by way of Clerkage.
4.	Out of Pocket Expenses	The amount required for court fees at the time of filing a case; and other miscellaneous expenses not exceeding Rs. 750/- should be obtained by the counsel in advance from the concerned branch/unit of CBI on whose behalf the Counsel will conduct the cases in the trial court. An account of the expenses incurred should be rendered to the concerned branch/Unit while presenting the final fee bill.
