Job Profile: Candidates are expected to do field visits, as and when required as per the demand of the project.

Roles and Responsibilities of Staff:

I. Palliative Care Doctor (One):

IPD –

- **1.** To take ward rounds daily.
- 2. Independently carry out a comprehensive patient assessment and develop a medical management plan.
- 3. Present the ward round to a senior palliative care physician.
- **4.** Ensure that inputs of Specialist Palliative care physicians in the team are sought, taken, documented, and implemented for patient care plans.
- 5. Maintain up-to-date and accurate documentation of care in patient records including electronic medical records.
- 6. Independently carry out minor procedures at ward level like nasogastric tube insertion, urinary catheter insertion, wound management, etc.
- 7. Keep up-to-date knowledge of the pharmacology of medications that are commonly used in palliative care.

OPD –

- 1. Provide clinical care to patients referred through external OPDs.
- 2. Triage the patients seen in external OPDs for OPD consultation or admission at day care or home care registration as per the need.

Home Care Visit -

1. Visit patients at homecare as per the schedule and needs of the family/patient.

II. <u>Project Coordinator (One):</u>

- Point of contact for coordinating various day to day activities in consultation with Project Lead.
- Will actively participate in the finalization of tools, recruitment of participants, fieldbased data collection, record keeping, implementation, and other project-related activities.
- Implementation of the project i.e., recruiting subjects, obtaining written informed consent, conducting interviews and data analysis, maintaining follow-up records, and data entering for the trial purpose.
- Organize time-to-time sensitization and training activities as required for the project.
- Responsible for the compilation of results and finalization of the report.
- Update the Project Lead regarding the progress of the project on a timely basis.
- Accomplish all the work as and when assigned towards project activities and candidature can be terminated if performance is not satisfactory.

III. Oncology Dietician (One):

- An oncology dietitian has to deal with cancer patients and their families to develop a diet during cancer treatment.
- Collaborate with the team to manage diet-related aspects of care, including designing nutrition interventions or assessments.
- Evaluate the patient's nutritional status and needs, including screening for malnutrition and assessing dietary intake.
- Oversse nutrition interventions, such as dietary counseling, tailored meal plans, or supplements.
- Provide ongoing dietary guidance and support to dietary guidance and support to participants, addressing any issues related to adherence or side effects.

Medical Social Worker (One)

- **1.** To assess the patient's and caregivers needs in terms of their social, financial and emotional concerns and their coping strategies.
- **2.** To maintain and update a list of resource organizations to support patients and caregivers.
- **3.** Work as a team member in the multidisciplinary team consisting of doctors, nursing and palliative care staff.
- 4. To coordinate and support the patients, family, and other team members.
- 5. To assist patients and families in understanding of the medical problem, in an appropriate language.
- 6. Preparing the patient and the families regarding their disease and disease progression and communicating the care and action plan appropriately to the patient and caregiver.
- **7.** To facilitate family meetings to support patients/persons with illness and his family with interpersonal issues as a result of illness.
- 8. To conduct group sessions where feasible to encourage peer-to-peer sharing of experiences.
- **9.** To conduct home visits where necessary to support patients with illness to adjust to his/her home environment, including encouraging independence in patients.
- **10.** To support the patient in a smooth transition from the hospital to the community and maintain the link with the patient, the community, and the health services.
- **11.** To be able to support families with bereavement counseling as and when needed.

<u>Mode of Selection</u>: Interview/ Written exam or both (at Academic Block, Medical College Building, AIIMS, Bathinda).
